As announced at the 2015 IAIABC Forum in April, WVOIC is pleased to announce that WVOIC is expanding reporting options for Trading Partners and will now accept the use of IAIABC Claims Release 3 Standards utilizing ACORD XML Standards. The use of the XML format is an option only and is not required by Trading Partners who prefer to continue to use the current IAIABC Release 3 Flat File.

WVOIC is currently seeking feedback from WVOIC Trading Partners who have an interest in testing and subsequently reporting First Report and Subsequent Report of Injury to WVOIC utilizing these IAIABC and ACORD XML standards.
